

Garbage

Garbage is collected from carts provided by the City of Marysville. Charges are based on cart size (20-96 gal).

- **Weight limit:** 65 lbs/32-gal container.
- **Double bag** pet litter, packing pellets, dusty debris, cool ashes.
- **Bulky items** like mattresses, appliances, and building materials can be picked up by special arrangement.

Extra garbage requires a pre-paid **garbage tag**. Each tag is good for one 32-gal. can, bag, or box (*limit 60 lbs*). Tags available at



Electronic & Hazardous Waste

Hazardous and medical wastes, fluorescent bulbs, needles, liquids, fuel tanks, computers and TVs are not allowed in garbage or recycling.

Yard Waste

Yard waste is discouraged from your garbage.

You can order a yard waste cart at 1-800-592-9995 or wmnorthwest.com.

Yard & Plant Trimmings:

Garden vegetation
Grass & leaves
Weeds & prunings
Branches under 4 ft. long, 4 in. diam.
Houseplants
Undecorated holiday trees (Limit 4 ft. long, 4 in. diam.)



Extra Yard Waste

Put yard trimmings that don't fit in your cart in any of these:

- **Kraft paper yard bags.**
- **32-gal. cans with handles & lids.** (Limit 55 lbs.)
 - ✓ Label cans "yard" & put your address on them.
 - ✓ Put yard trimmings in loosely, so that cans empty easily.
- **Bundles.** Use fiber twine. No wire, nylon or plastic cord. (Limit 4 ft. long by 4 ft. diam.)



No diapers
No pet waste/litter
No plastic bags
No food scraps
No metal
No glass
No hoses
No tarps
No liquids



Where Does Yard Waste Go?

Collected yard waste is processed into compost at local compost facilities and used to replenish soil in local parks and gardens.

DO NOT use plastic bags for yard waste.

Recycling

Empty recyclables out of bags, boxes and six-packs, and put them loose in the blue cart for sorting.

Clean Paper

Mail, envelopes
Newspaper
Flattened cardboard
Magazines, catalogs
Phone books
Paper boxes
(cereal, etc.) *No liners*
Gift wrap
(*No foil or ribbon*)

Paper Food Containers

Milk cartons
Juice boxes
Frozen food boxes

Clean Plastic

Plastic bottles, jugs
(*No caps or lids*)
Round dairy tubs
(yogurt, etc.)

Clean Glass

Glass bottles, jars
(*No caps or lids*)


Clean Metal

Aluminum & tin cans
Scrap metal
(limit 2x2x2 ft, 35 lbs)

Extra Recyclables

There is no charge for extra recyclables. Put extra recyclables in a recycling bin or cardboard box – **NO plastic bags!**

If you often have extra recyclables, order a larger recycling cart at no added charge.



No plastic bags
(Reuse or recycle them at grocery stores)
No shredded paper
(OK layered in yard cart)
No yard waste or food residue
No paper towels or napkins
(OK in yard cart)
No Styrofoam
No plastic trays, cups, plates or utensils
No mirrors, windows, dishes, or ceramics
No bathroom waste
(tissues, diapers)
No needles or syringes
No toxics containers
(auto products, pesticides, etc.)
