

## 45 mph winds rip area; minor damage

Many residents awoke Saturday morning to high winds, rain and no electricity. Power was out for anywhere from one hour to more than 12 hours in areas around the county Saturday when wind gusts of 45 miles hit the Marysville area downing power lines and trees.

Bob Klepper, park maintenance assistant and a member of the local H.A.M.S. radio operators club, recorded 45 mile gusts at Jennings Park on Saturday and 42 mile gusts on Sunday.

With the severe winds blowing moisture around, it appeared the City received a lot of rain with the wind storm.

However, Klepper only recorded .20 inches of rain on Saturday. Temperatures were 49 degrees with the low recorded at 47 degrees.

Klepper reported the park received little damage with just a few trees being blown down. However, that was not the case around the entire area. Area residents reported trees on power lines and in roads, making driving hazardous and in some cases broken windows and misplaced outdoor furniture.

The winds also posed a problem for firefighters Saturday while trying to extinguish a house fire.
