





NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1) Effective immediately, Marysville Emergency Administrative Order 2021-06 (Juror vaccination and/or rapid test status) is hereby terminated.
- 2) Beginning March 12, 2022, the Addendum to Marysville Emergency Administrative Order (Mask Policy) 2020-08 concerning the mask mandate (only) is terminated. All other portions, addressing social distancing and ill persons, remain in full force and effect. Individuals will still have the option to wear masks while in the courthouse building.
- 3) This court retains the right to require other remedial measures to mitigate any potential safety or health risks to staff, jurors, or the public, whether or not set forth in our emergency administrative orders.
- 4) Further, recognizing that the public health emergency created by the COVID-19 pandemic is still an ongoing emergency situation, this order may be revised or extended as necessary consistent with public health recommendations
